- Approval of the February 20th, 2019 Board Meeting minutes
- Treasurer's Report, Olan Kaigel: Beginning balance of \$42,013.48, deposit of \$7.83, withdrawals of \$8,942.01 leaving a balance of \$33,079.30
- Lake Perimeter Sign Project, Michelle Harms: Michelle is working closely with the city on content, design and color of signs to be used. The city has outlines of all the 10 signs and tentative placement, we will leave the sign placement to them. The city will be doing the installation of the signs. The city will contact the director of the zoo to get his help on the turtles. The city is interested in freshening up the existing signs displayed by the Audubon Society and The Native Tree Society. Michelle is also trying to contact the Salinian Indian Tribe for their input on a sign. Nancy Hair said she would contact the Santa Barbara Botanical Garden for information on Native usages of plants that surround the lake.
